What Is a Critical Care Problem?

A “Critical Care Problem” is defined as a condition where an entire group is prevented from performing critical tasks using the P4 server (P4D).

Examples of Critical Care Problems:

1. Failure of the P4 server (P4D) following a server upgrade
2. Denial of access to the P4 server
3. Hardware failure or crash requiring recovery of the P4 server.

For example:

Again, my name is Bruno at Perforce and I can be reached at 415-555-1212.
